Ask a Librarian is Florida's free online chat service where students can connect to a librarian to get assistance with all of their research needs.

Get Help with: Research, Using Databases, and Searching the Web

Ask a Librarian uses Instant Messaging technology and the ability to co-browse web pages and databases in order to provide students with the assistance and the resources they need to complete assignments from the convenience of their own home at their moment of need.

Librarians are standing by to answer questions from 10-10 Sunday- Friday and 10-5 Saturday. Students can also request assistance through email 24 a hours day, 7 days a week.
