

Annual Report 2008-2009



About

Ask a Librarian is a free online service that allows Floridians to chat live with a librarian for immediate assistance using authoritative sources. A trained information professional can guide you to the answers you need in minutes rather than your wasting hours navigating hundreds of unhelpful and irrelevant web sites. 103 libraries statewide collaborate to provide this service to their users and the users of other participating libraries. Ask a Librarian is managed by the Tampa Bay Library Consortium and is funded as part of the Florida Electronic Library by a Library Services and Technology Act (LSTA) grant.

Overview of 08-09

2008-2009 was a year of transition and continued growth for Ask a Librarian. On October 1, 2008, we changed software platforms from SirsiDynix's Docutek to InstantService. The new software platform offers several advantages, including: scalability, flexibility and a feature rich software that will help Florida remain on the forefront of virtual reference

Use increased 14% from 46,244 questions in 2007-08 via email and chat to 52,729 in 2008-09; five percent higher than originally anticipated. This includes 38,365 questions via live chat and 14,364 via email. Since 2002, Ask a Librarian has answered 204,212 questions for Florida residents, 143,154 via live chat.

Last year, several libraries joined Ask a Librarian including Florida A&M University, Hernando County Public Library, High Tech Institute, Marion County Public Library System, Monroe County Public Library and North Palm Beach Public Library. Moffitt Cancer Center, Morton Plant Mease Medical Library, Shriners Hospital and the medical librarian at St Petersburg College are joining Ask a Librarian as TABAMLN (Tampa Bay Medical Library Network), a specialized desk focusing on email referrals for health related questions from their users and other libraries.

Promoting Ask a Librarian

Marketing is a central focus of Ask a Librarian and is essential to our success. Without constant marketing, Florida residents would not be aware of the great service they have available at their fingertips. Ask a Librarian conducted several unique marketing campaigns focusing on different audience segments.

- On February 20, 2009, librarians all over Florida celebrated the first ever Ask a Librarian Day, an event which kicked off a longer word-of-mouth marketing (WOMM) campaign. Librarians donned t-shirts (donated by Gale), and distributed stickers and Ask a Librarian business cards to colleagues and customers with the Ask a Librarian name and logo to start a conversation about Ask a Librarian. http://info.askalibrarian.org/aal_day.asp
- For the second year, Ask a Librarian held **The Director's Chair**, a contest in which Florida high school students created their own 30-second Ask a Librarian commercials. We received 28 entries and over 1,200 Floridians voted for their favorite video to determine the winner. Year 3 is currently underway. www.askalibrarian.org/directorschair for details.



Widgets and Beyond

Ask a Librarian actively worked with libraries to get the Ask a Librarian logo a more prominent location on their web sites. Experience has shown that links on front pages of websites, in catalogs, and databases directly correlate with higher use. Custom widgets are available for libraries using Ask a Librarian. Widgets can vary from embedded buttons to Meebo-like chat boxes embedded within a web page to dynamic buttons. Provide roving reference on your website with Ask a Librarian's InstantInvite feature. In 2009-10, libraries will be able to add proactive chat to their web pages. With criteria set up by each library, an invitation to chat will appear for the user. InstantInvite is a great addition to login pages, resources pages and other parts of your web page where users need assistance.

Mentoring

Launched in October 2009, the new mentoring program matches those new to Ask a Librarian with seasoned virtual librarians. Mentors help newcomers in applying their knowledge and skills in a myriad of ways, from live, one-on-one guidance during actual patron chats to anytime-emails of reassurance or feedback and support. Training

Ask a Librarian has more training options than ever before. We offer full-day face to face training for those new to Ask a Librarian. Supplemental online training on the service's options and the skills needed to be a successful digital librarian are regularly offered. Additionally, online tutorials are available in the Ask a Librarian Toolbox and a bi-weekly newsletter, TGIF is available to all participants through the AskRef list.

Quality Assurance Workgroup and the Exemplary Reference Awards

The Quality Assurance Workgroup is an integral part of our success. This workgroup, made up of members from participating libraries, works with the Virtual Reference Manager and Virtual Reference Coordinator to ensure the highest level of customer service and to award monthly 'Exemplary Reference Awards' in three categories: Brief Chat, Detailed Chat and Teaching Chat. The Detailed Chat Award is accompanied by a \$20 gift card to Amazon.com. These awards turn the evaluation into a good natured competition and the exemplary sessions are used as training tools.
